GRO POD IS MAKING A BIG DIFFERENCE

Join Us In Making A Difference This Month

The GRO Pod is an intense spiritual and life skills class designed to immerse inmates in biblical knowledge and teach them life skills to stop the cycle of recidivism. Statistics from the program indicate that recidivism rates dropped from 76% to 25%.

A generous donor has offered to match **EVERY** dollar given over our normal monthly gifts in May, up to **\$5,000**.

We have an opportunity to **double or even triple** our monthly offerings. Since we are behind in our fiscal year budget ending June 30th, additional help is sorely needed. The GRO Pod is at risk of being discontinued without this needed yearly support. Chaplain Al Novak reminds us that “the GRO Pod and all of our daily

programs in the jail share the glory of Jesus Christ and makes disciples of many”.

GRO Pod results show that less than 1 out of 4 graduates return to jail or prison. Traditionally, 3 out of 4 inmates will return in three years.

The Genesee Mission graduates over 100 students each year and plans are in the works to increase our graduates to 150 students per year. We are making disciples and lowering our tax burden as we reduce repeat offenders. This is a win-win situation.

Lives are being changed; hope is being renewed; and you can be a part of it all. Giving is easy.
